A performance examiner is required to:

Have avacaioned in the test mathed being and stad
Have experience in the test method being conducted.
Be certified in the area of the performance exam.
Verify all steps of the method.
Have a positive attitude.
Not be in the chain of command or related to the examinee.
Review current Performance Exam Checklists

THE PERFORMANCE EXAM GUIDELINES:

Before the trial, the technician may ask questions about the use of specific equipment, such as scales / balances, shakers, etc. Do not provide training for the performance exam, but do clarify the operation of the equipment.

Provide the technician with a clean copy of the short form FOP for that test method. Books or notes are not allowed.

Take possession of the technicians' performance exam check list and <u>verify the name and</u> date.

Do not respond to questions or assist the technician in any way during the trial.

Each test method must be performed in its entirety in the examiners' presence. Explain allowed acceleration such as assumed drying or soaking time, before trial begins.

Some methods may be performed verbally, direct technician to describe the steps in their entirety.

Score the technician's performance based solely on the performance exam checklist.

Place a **P** or **F** on the line associated with each step of the trial being performed.

Do not stop the trial when an error is made. Allow the technician to complete the trial.

Do not indicate approval or disapproval either audibly or physically.
